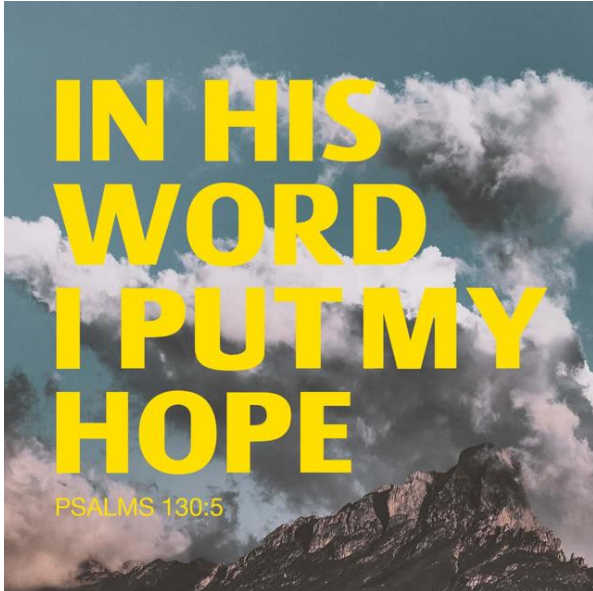


Uckfield Baptist Church
